

**PLANS AND ESTIMATES FOR CITY OF PERRY AMBULANCE SERVICES TO BE FUNDED BY SPECIAL ASSESSMENT OF THE CITY OF PERRY AMBULANCE SERVICES SPECIAL ASSESSMENT DISTRICT OF 2021**

It is estimated that the amount necessary to be raised by special assessment to fund ambulance services for the City of Perry Special Assessment District is \$66,950.00. This sum shall be spread as follows:


Each parcel of property within the district having at least one unit as defined below shall be assessed at a rate not to exceed sixty five dollars (\$65.00) per unit.

A "unit" is defined as any of the following:


- a. A single family residence;
- b. A mobile home being used as a dwelling;
- c. A residential apartment in a multiple-family structure or a multiple-use structure;
- d. A commercial or business property with zero (0) to five (5) full-time employees. An additional assessment shall be placed upon any such parcel for each multiple of five (5) full-time employees or part thereof. For purposes of computing the assessment under this definition, a full-time employee shall be counted for each 40 hours of wages paid by the employer in the week proceeding this hearing.

If the City of Perry elects to create a Special Assessment District with a duration longer than one year, then it is anticipated that the cost for ambulance services will increase in the future at a rate not greater than ten percent (10%) per annum and that a redetermination of costs will be made by the Perry City Council each year hereafter at the first City Council meeting at the Perry City Hall, however, the formula by which the benefit is determined and the burden established will remain unchanged.
