b.	area	<b>constrated Benefit.</b> The PUD shall result in an improvement to the public health, safety, and welfare in affected or a recognizable public benefit. Such public benefit shall be evaluated in contrast to a project d otherwise be permitted, on factors such as:
	1.	Preservation of unique site design features;
	2.	High quality architectural design;
	3.	Extensive landscaping beyond site plan requirements of the Zoning Code;
	4.	Preservation, enhancement, or restoration of natural resources (trees, slopes, nonregulated wetland are etc.)
	5.	Incorporation of multiple lots and/or principal buildings;
	6.	Preservation or enhancement of historic resources;
	7.	Provision of open space or public plazas or features;
	8.	Efficient consolidation of poorly dimensioned parcels or property with difficult site conditions (e.g. topograshape, etc.);
	9.	Effective transition between higher and lower density uses, and/or between nonresidential and resider uses; or allow incompatible adjacent land uses to be developed in a manner that is not possible using conventional approach;
	10.	Shared vehicular access between properties or uses;
	11.	A complementary mix of uses or a variety of housing types; and
	12.	Mitigation to offset impacts on public facilities (such as road improvements).

a.	For residential projects only, a parallel plan or conventional plan showing the development possible

	dimensional standards permitted in the PUD.	
b.	A conceptual or schematic plan that illustrates the general arrangement of buildings, parking, access,	
	and landscaping; alternatives for site arrangement and building architecture are suggested.	
C.	Documentation indicating how the PUD eligibility criteria of Section 9.02 have been met.	
d.	A table which details requested modifications from the established zoning district uses, area, height,	
	and setback requirements, off-street parking regulations, general provisions or subdivision regulations	
	which would otherwise be applicable to the uses and development proposed in comparison to the	
	requested modification,	
e.	Any additional information requested by the planning commission at the preapplicaition conference to	
	better assist in the determination of PUD qualification. Such information includes, but is not limited to:	
	market studies, fiscal impact analysis, traffic impact analysis, environmental impact assessments, and

	<b>Completed Plan.</b> A completed concept or final plan including all elements specified above as required for proposed development and property.
	<b>Application Form and Fees.</b> A completed application form and an application fee are required with the initial submittal. (Application Fee - \$500.00, Basic Escrow Deposit - \$750.00. Escrow is subject to increase depending on complexity of the project.)
	<b>Proof of Ownership.</b> Current proof of ownership of the land to be utilized or evidence of a contractual ability to acquire such land, i.e., copy of deed. (A copy of the tax bill is not sufficient proof of ownership.)
	<b>Copies.</b> At the time of initial submittal four (4) folded copies of Plans that comply with the above criteria to the City Clerk twenty-one (21) days prior to the Planning Commission meeting. At the time of final submittal, fifteen (15) sets of 11" x 17" plans are required.
	<b>Final PUD Site Plan Approval Process.</b> The Final PUD Site Plan Approval Process will commence if and when the PUD Concept Plan is approved with or without conditions.
