

Perry City Parks and Property Meeting Minutes Notes

June 6, 2012

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm.

Minutes:

Wood asked for approval of the minutes as presented from May 16, 2012 meeting and Wekwert, Johnson and Dunn agreed for the approval of the minutes.

Old Business:

Skate Parks-

Johnson suggested that a five year plan be made for the parks and would like Mrs. Tobias to be invited. Wekwert agreed and would invite Mrs. Tobias.

Flag Poles-

- Mr. Cords reported he is in contact with Ameritime Museum and has the letter to request flag and pole. He also reported that the VFW and AmVets are working on fundraisers for the flag poles.

- Bruce Sanfilippo came to ask what the Lions could do as an organization for the community. He said, after a survey was done, the public asked if improvements could be done on Jubilee Park. Lions would like to target Jubilee Park as a project. Lions have some funding available for supplies and would offer labor. Johnson said he would supply and inventory a list of items needed to be done at Jubilee Park for next meeting. Lions said they would attend the Parks and Property's next meeting.

- Wood called the next meeting to be July 11th at 7pm.

Johnson suggested selling bricks to utilize the money to purchase the flag poles. Committee suggested selling the bricks ahead of time to be ready to be placed around the flags. Committee would like to find someone to draw a picture of the Memorial Park Plan and have it advertised at the park, website and newspaper for the sale of bricks. Johnson suggested that all polls be put in before flags are put on. Cost of the flag will be 2 inch top and 4 inch bottom \$622.00 plus \$55 for the plaque on the flag pole recognizing who contributed the flag pole. Mr. Cords is willing to buy the first one to get the ball rolling. Six flag poles will cost $\$677 \times 6 = \406 . The suggested price of bricks is \$75 for a small brick and \$125 for a large brick.

- Jo Ann Velting was explaining a sample picture given to committee regarding multiple ball fields.

New Business:

Pavilion Policy-

Wood would like to see City Hall have a rental schedule for the pavilion. Johnson would like to see a split fee which means residents would get a cheaper rate. Committee recommends \$25 fee for a resident and \$50 fee for outside resident. Committee would like a box at the pavilion to post reservations.

Other Business:

Side walk-

Chuck asked Committee to open the sidewalk bids for Jubilee Park, Memorial Park and Perry School. Bids were opened by Wekwert. Bids were from FTS Companies, BL Bennet and Jeff's Concrete. Committee has decided to have copies made for all Council and have Council decide the bid.
