Meeting called to order at 7:03 pm.

Old Business:

Flag Poles-

Mr. Cords is working on the VFW to support the funding for the flag poles in the veterans park.

Cost of the Pavilion-

Mr. Johnson inquired the cost of electric and gas for the pavilion. Mr. Wood reported the bill averaged about \$40.00 a month. Mr. Mudge reported that Jubilee restrooms are open by appointment only and restrooms at City Hall will be open for public use 24/7 unless vandalism occurs. If vandalism occurs, surveillance cameras will need to be researched and purchased.

Mr. Mudge will be handling the cleaning, supplying and maintenance of the restrooms and costs will come out of parks and recs.

New Business:

Perry Softball/Baseball Association-

Mrs. Potter explained that the association is its own entity, would like to utilize the fields and next year look at possibly merging with the Morrice teams. The League would like to utilize the ball fields which would include working them along with playing on them. The Association would like permission from the City to work and play on the fields and next year they would like to partner with the City so the association can contribute by chalking the fields, maintaining the fields and empty trash. Association is going to try to get tournaments set up in the City for next year. The Association would also like to coordinate the City fields and make schedules of the games. Mrs. Potter suggested a sign put up at the City fields showing reservations of the games.

Other Business:

Play structure-Mr. Johnson suggested that the City needs to proceed in implementing a play structure. Possibly make it happen with donations. He also agreed to research and speak to the committee who made the Williamston Play structure happen and bring back to Parks and Rec committee. Mr. Johnson would also like to invest and look at a future skate park. He requested any past minutes and maps from Parks and Property pertaining to the skate park.

No Parking During Parade-Mr. Johnson suggested that Main St. parking be blocked during parades.

Throwing Candy During a Parade- There currently isn't a policy.
