

Perry City Parks and Property Meeting Minutes Notes

July 11, 2012

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm.

Minutes:

Wekwert asked for approval of the minutes as presented from June 6, 2012 meeting and Johnson and Dunn agreed for the approval of the minutes.

Old Business:

Flag Poles-

- Mr. Cords reported he has submitted the information requested from Ameritime Museum and is now waiting for their answer. He also reported that the price per flagpole has been quoted \$519.00 and the plaque is \$55.00 which saved \$111.00 from the original quote. This would include 6 flagpoles for a total price \$3114.00, also include flags total price \$3874.00. Mr. Cords confirmed that he will be purchasing a flagpole. The other flag poles are trying to be done by fundraisers. He currently has 2 fundraisers July 28th pig roast and August 12th golf outing.
- Mr. Johnson asked permission to pursue the idea of selling the bricks to raise money for the Memorial Park. It was suggested that this could be on the website help promote selling this.

Jubilee Park Repairs-

Bruce Sanfilippo asked for a list of repairs of Jubilee park. He was asking for approval to go forward with a plan to figure out what projects the Lions could prioritize at the park. Chuck Mudge suggested that possibly use funds in park maintenance to purchase the items needed and Lions are proposing to offer free labor to make Jubilee back to a safe playground. Parks and Property committee agreed to allow the Lions to go forward with a plan. The Lions have done a survey to the Perry area and are willing to share their results with Parks and Property committee.

Pavilion Policy-

Devin Miller explained that the pavilion policy presented to the parks is a rough draft. There are several decisions that need to be decided to be placed in the policy. She also explained that Dori and she are working on a future drop down on the City's website for the parks. Dori Boertman explained that an idea is to use plastic box like the realtor's use for notice of future use.

Skate Parks-

Mike Johnson reported that he spoke to Mr. Leland Scott about creating a drawing similar to the half pipe that is located in Owosso for cost of \$75.00. Once the drawing is made his suggestion is to go to find out the prices of the material to make a half pipe. The idea is to make this half pipe mobile because there have been some concerns if a skate park fad is gone.

Moved by Johnson, seconded by Dunn to put on the agenda the request to purchase drawing from Mr. Leland Scott.

New Business:

Master Plan-Brad Sharlow, Planning Commission chair, spoke about the updating of the master plan and would like to see the update completed by the end of the this year. He is asking the parks and property committee have a brain storm meeting to update the chapter pertaining to the parks and recreation. He also, noted that the 5 year parks and recreation plan has lapsed and would like to see this updated and could be incorporated in the master plan. He would also like to see the City collaborate with Perry and Woodhull Township for rails for trails.
