

Notice: Draft Master Plan Presentation

The City of Perry Planning Commission along with its partners will host a presentation regarding the City Master Plan at 7 p.m. Tuesday, Feb. 12, in the Perry Middle School auditorium.

During the presentation, several presenters from different areas will utilize a PowerPoint presentation outlining goals and objectives of each department for the upcoming years, including police, public works, parks and recreation, transportation, business and industry, land use, SSES (fire and ambulance), the Community District Library and Perry Public Schools.

The Planning Commission will also report results of the residential and business surveys while discussing areas the people identified as what their priorities would be for upcoming years. Public comment will also be allowed to discuss these ideas.

“This is by no means a final list, but a starting point for putting everything together,” said Planning Commission Chairperson Brad Sharlow.

The city plans to adopt the new Master Plan in May 2013. In addition, the City of Perry is beginning a separate Parks and Recreation Plan, which is being developed with Michigan State University. The plan was kicked-off Monday, Feb. 4, with Commission members presenting a summary of what was discussed at a recent meeting as well as the next steps needed to complete the plan.

Attendance is strongly encouraged. “Your input is very important to us,” said Sharlow, “and we hope to take everyone’s ideas and concerns into consideration.
