PS Food Mart - Subway, on the southeast corner of S. M-52 and Lansing road on the north side of Perry, is this month's recipient of the "Put Your Best Face Forward" award presented by the City of Perry. They were selected to display the traveling trophy in the establishment for one month by Mayor Ross DeLau.

After being purchased by Folk Oil in April 2010, the facility was remodeled throughout, including two extremely sanitary restrooms, one of the company's signature trademarks. Landscaping and placement of the U.S. Flag (another signature trademark) in front of the building enhances the exterior of the building.

Other features include a Subway sandwich shop, available from inside the building or through the drive-up window, a Java Peak gourmet coffee area, cold beverages, ice, snacks, and much more plus, of course, gasoline for your vehicle.

The Perry PS Food Mart, one of 30 owned by Folk Oil, is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week; however, Subway closes at 10 p.m.
