



Household Hazardous Waste Collection



When: **Saturday, May 14, 2022**

Where: Perry City Hall, 203 W. Polly St., Perry

Time: 8:00 am to 12:00 pm *no appointment necessary*

Acceptable Items Include:

- * Oil-based paints and varnishes
- * Wood preservatives
- * Cleaning solvents
- * Pesticides and weed killers
- * Household batteries
- * Oven cleaners
- * Mothballs
- * Transmission fluid and antifreeze
- * Pressurized cans
- * Metallic mercury (thermometers and fluorescent bulbs)
- * Lead (found in shot and sinkers)

Shiawassee County's population has the potential to produce over 500,000 pounds of unregulated household hazardous waste annually.



Handling and Transportation of Materials:

- * Put closed containers in boxes and place in trunk of car
- * Do not mix materials
- * Do not carry boxes or containers in your lap
- * Staff will remove the material from your trunk when you arrive at the facility
- * You will not even need to leave your car
- * Licensed haulers will be contracted to transport the material to be recycled, reused, or disposed of in an environmentally friendly manner

Items NOT Accepted:

- * Latex paint
- * Tires
- * Used motor oil
- * Smoke detectors
- * Explosives

Most HHW is stored in our homes, dumped in our backyards, and poured into our septic systems or lakes and streams
