TUESDAY, AUGUST 2, 2022

TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF PERRY:

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that any qualified elector of the City of Perry who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk; the office of the county Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at [mi.gov/vote](https://mi.gov/vote) and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at <https://mvic.sos.state.mi.us/register voter>.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **JULY 18, 2022**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the City of Perry Clerk's office, located at  
203 W. Polly St., Perry, MI 48872 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday thru Friday from 8am to 4:00pm
- Saturday, July 30<sup>th</sup> from 9am to 5pm
- Election Day, Tuesday, August 2, 2022 from 7am to 8pm

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** the August 2, 2022 Primary Election is an Open Primary along with three proposals. There are two Party sections on the ballot: Republican Party and Democratic Party. Select the party section of your choice. **YOU MAY VOTE IN ONE PARTY SECTION ONLY.** You may not split your ticket in a primary election. If you vote in more than one party section, the partisan portion of you ballot will be rejected. See below ballot items:
