- Item #1 for New Business: Approval of Revised Zoning Change Recommendation Centered Around Medical Marijuana

Muller summarizes revisions requested by ordinance committee. Changes include slight spelling adjustments and the addition of the City of Perry Zoning Administrator approval requirement in Section 15.07 FF. 3.

Muller motions that we approve the revisions as presented. Cottrell seconds. Approved unanimously.

- Item #2 for New Business: To Reschedule Public Hearing Pertaining to Proposed Zoning Change Recommendations Centered Around Medical Marijuana.

Muller describes the need to reschedule the public hearing due to time constraints. Not enough time was provided to the City Clerk to meet the originally intended March 7<sup>th</sup> timeline. Muller suggests April 4<sup>th</sup> as an alternative.

Muller motions for approval to move the public hearing pertaining to our proposed zoning change recommendations centered around medical marijuana to April 4<sup>th</sup>, at 7 p.m. Ottke seconds. Approved unanimously.

**Other Comments:**

A concerned citizen reached out to Ottke to describe an issue with the elementary school pick-up and drop-off times. They described the need for more a more consistent, structured process. There have been several instances where busses have been unable to reach their designated spots due to cars blocking their path.

Galbavi offers to speak with the Mayor to determine what has already been done to help this situation. Galbavi suggests the Police and Fire Departments may have also have more information. The Planning Commission agrees that this topic should be included on the agenda for April 4<sup>th</sup>.
